

## JANUARY 2017: GO UANDES Leadership

"Leadership in a Chilean and Latin-American context"

The dates of the program are:

The GO UANDES Leadership Program provides a unique opportunity for students to experience the Chilean culture and understand the local environment. Students will learn with Chilean professors and peers, about Economics, Politics, cultural aspects and social trends of Chile and the region. It will provide a cross-cultural experience that will be difficult to forget!

Students can choose to take part of the 2-, 3- or a 4-week program during **January**, enjoying summer at the UANDES Campus.

Contents

The 4-week program (80 hours) has 34 contact hours of lectures taught by UANDES faculty, guest speakers and external lectures about Chilean Economy and Entrepreneurship, Leadership and Chilean culture, 16 hours of Spanish as a Foreign Language and 30 hours approximately of field trips and off-campus activities, where students can discover Santiago and our cultural traditions.

At the end of the program, each student will receive a transcript of records with the credits obtained. These credits vary depending on the weeks spent in the program. <u>More Info</u>.

## Program cost

For partner institutions the *tuition fee is waived*. Participants only pay the Application & Program fee.

The application and program fee include: Welcome kit, program materials, on-campus facilities (library, sports), off-campus cultural trips and activities, accompanied by a student coordinator, among others.
