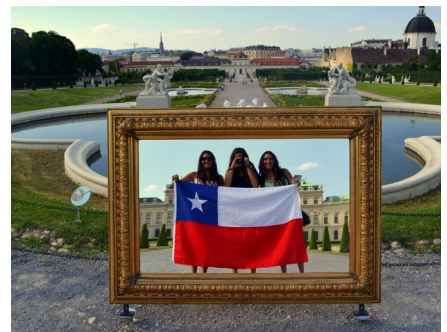
- > Ranked fourth in Chile according to the student's scores on the National Admissions Test (PSU) 2016.

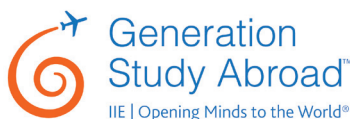
