SERVICES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

HOUSING

The International Relations Office provides students a list of recommended housing options as Universidad de los Andes does not offer on-campus accommodation. These include homestay with Chilean families, residences or shared flats.

ARRIVAL ASSISTANCE

Universidad de los Andes can arrange a pick-up service at the Santiago International Airport. There are different alternatives such as bus to the subway, taxi or van.

ORIENTATION WEEK

All students will be welcomed with an orientation week at the beginning of the semester. It is a complete week that includes information about the University, campus tour, cultural trips and activities, buddy program presentation, organizational and visa matters, meeting with our team and UANDES Faculty.

STUDENT ASSOCIATION AND BUDDY PROGRAM

ARI (Asociación de Relaciones Internacionales) is an organization dedicated to integrate international students to UANDES.
