COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course's main objective is to give students a global perspective of the importance of APEC while immersed in the Chilean cultural scenario. Therefore, the course will consist of two main units: one related to APEC and its economies and commercial relations, and the second one related to Chile's cultural reality through different perspectives. Additionally, this course includes a Language Unit, that can be either Spanish for non-Spanish speakers, or English for Spanish speakers.

METHODOLOGY AND ACTIVITIES

This course will include lectures by different UANDES professors and external lecturers, that will involve student interaction.

Students will have to choose a topic related to APEC on which they will work through the duration of the program, and will have to present it at the end of the course. They will be graded in accordance to the development of the paper, and the final presentation.

Finally, the language course will include a final exam during the last week of the program.
