TRANSVERSAL REQUIREMENTS UANDES

These requirements are the same for all international students applying for an exchange at the Universidad de los Andes, whether for a semester or a year.

- > Passport valid throughout the entire duration of the international student's stay in Chile.
- > Letter of Commitment signed by the international student. This document will be sent to the student along with the link to complete the online application form. However, you can find it on the UANDES website, in the international section (<https://www.uandes.cl/internacional>).
- > ID size photo of the international student, which must be in color and recent.
- > Academic records of the international student from all his/her university years: the document must include the current year in which the international student is at his/her home university, subjects taken and corresponding grades.
- > Motivation letter written by the international student: extension of one page and must be written in English or Spanish (depending on which courses the student has selected to take at UANDES).
- > Selection of a maximum of 4 courses to study at UANDES.

All this information must be included in the Online Application Form that will be sent to the international students nominated to come to UANDES for an exchange. This form must be completed and sent by the student himself before the deadline:

- > For applications for an exchange during the first UANDES academic semester (March to July), the deadline for completing the form is: mid-November of the year prior to the exchange.
- > For applications to an exchange during the second UANDES academic semester (from August to December), the deadline to complete the form is: mid-April of the same year of the exchange.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

These requirements are specific to coming on an academic exchange to the UANDES School of Occupational Therapy.

- > International students may select subjects from the third year of the program (5th and 6th semester). Applications to previous semesters will be subject to confirmation on behalf of the school.
- > International students who wish to apply for an internship must:
 - > Specify the request in the online application form, in the section "Course Selection".
Wait for a first confirmation from International Relations and then from the School of Occupational Therapy.
 - > Applications for internships will only be accepted in specific cases. The course will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- > For courses involving intervention, students must have a white apron. For more information on these subjects, please contact incoming@uandes.cl.
- > Language certificate:
 - > Spanish B2 level: for all those international students whose native language is not Spanish and who select subjects taught in Spanish.
 - > Spanish B1 level: for all those international students whose native language is not Spanish and who select subjects taught in Spanish along with the Spanish as a Foreign Language course offered by the International Relations Office every semester.

The UANDES School of Occupational Therapy will carry out an evaluation of the courses selected by the international students applying, along with a review of their Academic Records and may make changes if deemed necessary.
