## "Universidad de los Andes & University of Auckland Public Engagement with Research Fund"

Dear Researchers,

We are pleased to announce the completion of the evaluation and selection process for the "Universidad de los Andes & University of Auckland Public Engagement with Research Fund." A total of ten proposals were admitted for evaluation; five were pre-selected based on their GREF application and then reviewed by two independent experts: a subject-matter technical reviewer and an international specialist in Public Engagement.

Based on the evaluation results and the budget available, funding has been awarded to the two highest-scoring proposals among those that were technically qualified. It is worth noting that all five pre-selected proposals were technically qualified, reflecting the overall strength and quality of the submissions.
